GRANTS & SCHOLARSHIPS



RESOURCE, PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, AND PROGRAM GRANTS

Deadline: 15 of January, April, July & October

Eligibility: current CAAS member

Requirements: grant proposal form & full report

Professional Development: up to \$1000 to individual educators for continuing education

Resource: up to \$600 to individual educators for teaching resources, software, classroom tech, purchasing publications, field trips & speakers

Program: up to \$2000 to programs that promote Classics among a wider audience

GRANTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Deadline: rolling through June 1

Eligibility: student in grades 9-12 residing in the CAAS region

Maximum award: \$2500

Requirements: application, rec letter & reflection

Purpose:

- Tuition for Classics-related courses or projects
- Summer Classics-related programs
- Class attendance at the NJCL convention
- Bringing a Classics program to a school

LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE GRANTS

Deadline: rolling

Eligibility: current CAAS member

Maximum award: \$3000

Purpose: advance the mission of CAAS to promote better teaching, encourage research, and foster public support of the Classics

Requirements: application & full report

E. ADELAIDE HAHN SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline: March 15

Eligibility: current CAAS member

Maximum award: \$7000

Purpose: summer session of the American School of Classical Studies at Athens (ASCSA) or the American Academy in Rome (AAR)

Requirements: application & presentation

NEW: DR. RUDOLPH MASCIANTONIO GRANTS

Deadline: rolling

Eligibility: current CAAS member

Maximum award: case-by-case

Purpose: primarily "direct-to-students" Classics programs

Requirements: letter to co-chairs Henry Bender & Mary Brown containing proposal & projected budget; full report
